Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

A federally funded program that helps low-income individuals heat and cool their homes. HEAP consists of 5 components:



Regular HEAP: Yearly benefits to assist in paying for home heating.



Clean and Tune Benefit: Energy efficiency services to allow for proper and efficient operation of equipment



Heating Equipment Repair or Replacement Benefit: Repair or replace direct heating equipment needed to keep home's main heating source working



Cooling Assistance: Buying and installing an AC unit or fan in home



Emergency HEAP Benefit: Home heating during heat or heatrelated emergencies
