## Utility Bill Resources

- **New York's Energy Affordability Policy:** Provides discount on electric and/or gas bills as well as other benefits. Learn more: <https://dps.ny.gov/energy-affordability-program>
- **Weatherization Assistance Program:** Enables reduced bills by making households more energy efficient. Call: (518)-474-5700
- **Emergency Rental Assistance Fund (ERAP):** Economic relief to those at risk of homelessness or housing instability. Call: (844)-691-7368

## Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

A federally funded program that helps low-income individuals heat and cool their homes. HEAP consists of 5 components:

- 1 Regular HEAP:** Yearly benefits to assist in paying for home heating.
- 2 Clean and Tune Benefit:** Energy efficiency services to allow for proper and efficient operation of equipment
- 3 Heating Equipment Repair or Replacement Benefit:** Repair or replace direct heating equipment needed to keep home's main heating source working
- 4 Cooling Assistance:** Buying and installing an AC unit or fan in home
- 5 Emergency HEAP Benefit:** Home heating during heat or heat-related emergencies
